Ride Directions

Important—Please contact Betsy or Dave by Tuesday if you plan on going on the ride and having lunch.

Date: Thursday, April 28, 2011, **9:30 a.m.**

Destination: Tybee Island, GA. *Be aware that the driving time from mid-island Hilton Head to Tybee is about an hour and 20 minutes.*

Directions to the departure point: Take US 278 west to Burnt Church Road. Turn left on Burnt Church and continue to Bruin Road where you will turn right. Later it becomes May River Road (SC 46) until you come to the traffic circle. Go through the circle and continue on SC 170 until you come to US 17. Turn left on 17 and continue to the Talmage Bridge. Take the first exit after crossing the bridge to Oglethorpe Avenue. Continue on Oglethorpe for two blocks to Martin Luther King Boulevard where you will turn left. Continuing north on King Boulevard for about 2 blocks to Bay Street where you will turn right. Continue on Bay Street for several blocks until it becomes President Street. Turn left at this light and you are now on GA 80. While the names may change on GA 80, it will continue on to Tybee. After you get on Tybee Island continue until you come to the first traffic light at Campbell Avenue where you will turn left. A Chevron Station is on the left corner and the Visitors Center a bright yellow building--is on the right corner (the GPS address is 802 1st Street, Tybee Island, GA). Continue on Campbell until you reach a yellow house at the end of the street. Turn right on Van Horn and almost immediately turn left into the parking lot for Jaycee Park.

A description of the ride: Almost all of this ride will be on streets with varying levels of traffic. Please ride single file and be careful. From the parking lot we will ride to the fort and the lighthouse area. We will not visit either attraction; however, bathroom facilities are available there. We will ride through the streets in the area surrounding the lighthouse and the fort. Following that we will ride many of the streets in the downtown area. Later, we will have another restroom break at the pier which is the center of the tourist area. After that we will return to the parking lot to prepare to go to lunch.
