

Ride Plan

Important – If you plan to ride, please notify the Ride Leader (not the Webmaster) by the TUESDAY before the Thursday ride. Also please indicate if you are staying for lunch or not.

Ride Location: Cat Island **Date:** March 7, 2024

Time: 10:00 please arrive by 9:45 to gear up

Max Speed: 11 mph Ride Length: 13 miles

Directions to Start: Immediately after crossing the McTeer Bridge from Port Royal on Highway 21, take a right onto the Island Causeway. Cat Island is the last of three Sea Islands on that road. Golf club is on the right just before the end of the road. Address for GPS: 8 Waveland Ave., Beaufort 29907. When you pull into Cat Island Golf Club parking lot, park all the way to the left.

Ride Description and/or Information: Cat Island always a beautiful, enjoyable ride. Although the island was once a nudist colony, it is now a beautiful golf course development on Cowan Creek.

We will ride at a leisurely pace: 10 miles per hour for about 11 miles. We will be riding on the road as there are no bike/walking trails. Auto traffic is very light, and the road surfaces are in good condition.

Restrooms: Before the ride, stop at Parker's at the corner of Ribault Road and Paris Avenue (the entrance to the village of Port Royal). There is no restroom on the ride.
